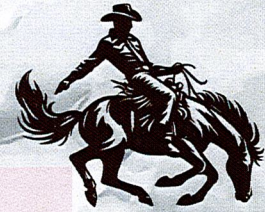

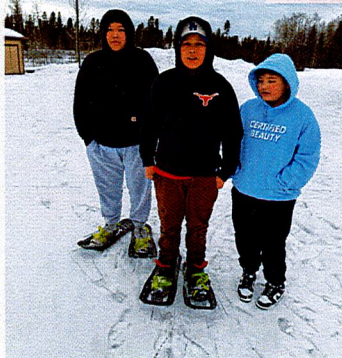

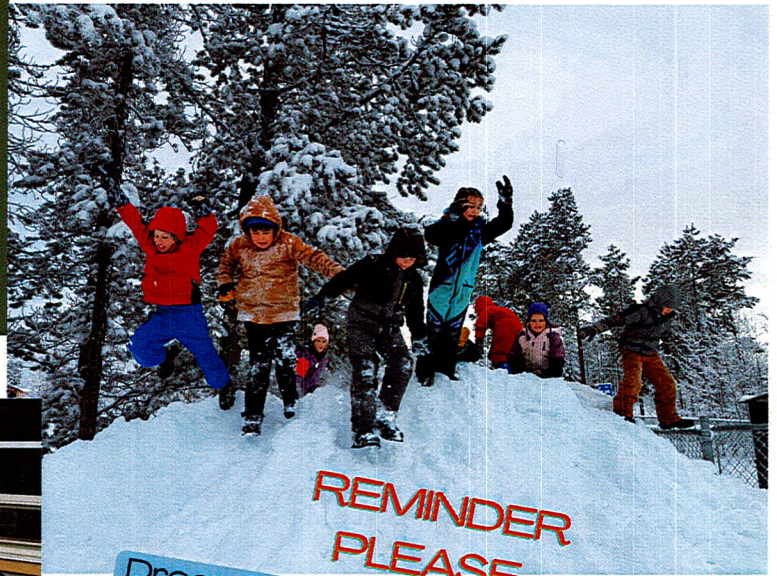

*This month, our students are exploring various math strategies, including counting on, rounding, and boosting their confidence in mental math with a range of tools.

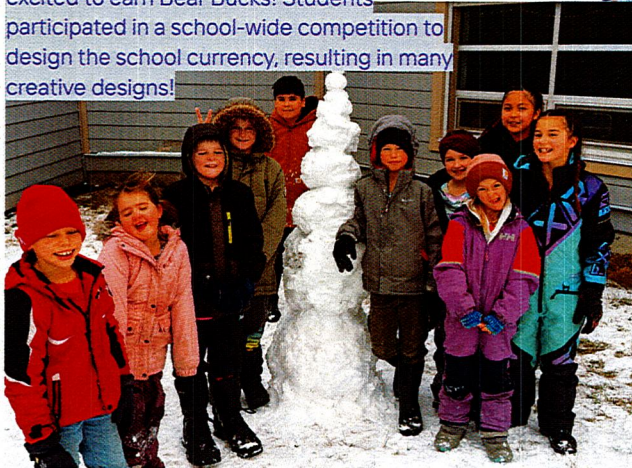
Our classroom jobs are diverse, and we're excited to earn Bear Bucks! Students participated in a school-wide competition to design the school currency, resulting in many creative designs!

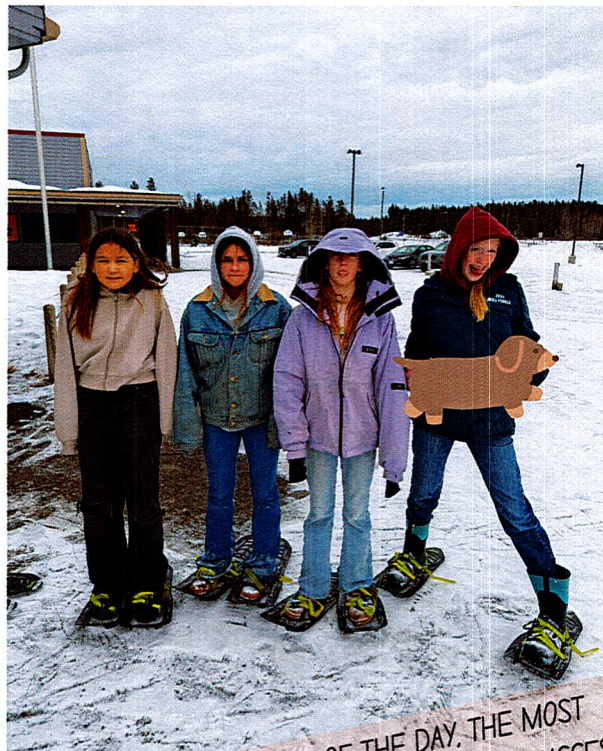
Dress for the weather, we are outside every morning, during recess, and lunch. Unless it is too cold or raining everyone needs to be outside.
